## TYRONE CCC YOUTH REGULATIONS 2020

## **FOOTBALL**

## (Amended Regulations)



- 1. All youth leagues grades will comprise of two groups of 6 teams (where possible)
- 2. The league will consist of 5 games (*where possible*)
- 3. The top two teams in a group will qualify for the league Semi-finals.
  - i. Group A winners Vs Group B Runner up (Group A winner will have home advantage)
  - ii. Group B winners Vs Group A Runner up (Group B winner will have home advantage)
- 4. The championship will be an open draw.
- 5. Any matches previously played prior to 1st April 2020 are now void.
- 6. No changing of time or date of a fixture will be permitted unless in very exceptional circumstances.
- 7. In the event that a new lock down is introduced, and all rounds of the league haven't been completed, then the 2020 league season will be declared null and void.
- 8. In the event that a new lock down is introduced, and all League rounds have been completed with the playoff matches pending, then these matches will be completed at the first available opportunity.
- 9. In the event that a new lock down is introduced and the championship has reached the semi-final or final stages then it will be completed at the first available opportunity.
- 10. When teams finish with equal points for qualification for the concluding stages, or for promotion or relegation, the tie shall be decided by the following means and in the order specified:
  - The outcome of the meeting(s) of the teams in the previous game(s) in the competition
  - ii) The largest scoring difference (subtracting the total scores against from the total scores for) in the meetings of the teams in the previous game(s)
  - iii) The highest total scores for, in the meeting(s) of the teams in the previous game(s)
  - Largest overall league scoring difference (subtracting the total scores against from total scores for)
  - v) The highest overall league total score for
  - vi) A playoff

- 11. League final stage games (Semi Finals, Finals etc.) and all Championship games will be winner on the day using the following protocol.
  - i. In the event of teams finishing level at the end of normal time, two ten minute periods will be played.
  - ii. If teams remain level at the conclusion of this extra time, a further two five minute periods will be played.
  - iii. If teams still remain level, at the conclusion of this second period of extra time, a third period will commence during which the first score will determine the outcome of the match.
- 12. Only League & Championship Finals will be played at neutral venues 1<sub>st</sub> team drawn out in Semi Finals will have home advantage.
- 13. Clubs can use unlimited subs in league games only.
